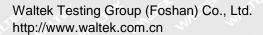

No.2: Red foam with red printing

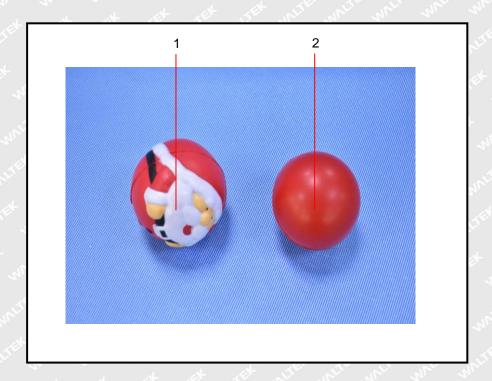
