### 4.3 Test conditions

#### 4.3.1 IP6X Test conditions

Dangerous parts protection test:

- 1) The Test prober of 1 mm diameter is pushed against any opening of the sample with force of 1 N;
- 2) Internal moving parts may be operated slowly, where this is possible.

Dust proof test:

- 1) Dust content of Dust Tester :2 kg/m<sup>3</sup>;
- 2) The talcum powder used shall be able to pass through a square-meshed sieve the nominal wire diameter of which is 50µm m and the nominal width of a gap between wires 75 µm;
- 3) Test duration:  
 If with a maximum depression of 2 kPa (20 mbar), an extraction rate of 40 to 60 volumes per hour is obtained the duration of the test is 2 h;  
 If with a maximum depression of 2 kPa (20 mbar), the extraction rate is less than 40 volumes per hour, the test is continued until 80 volumes have been drawn through, or a period of 8 h has elapsed;

#### 4.3.2 IPX5 Test conditions

Internal diameter of the nozzle: 6.3mm;

Delivery rate: 12.5 l/min ± 5 %;

Turntable rotation speed: 1 r/min;

Core of the substantial stream: circle of approximately 40 mm diameter at 2.5 m distance from nozzle;

Test duration per square metre of enclosure surface area likely to be sprayed: 1 min;

Minimum test duration: 3 min;

Distance from nozzle to enclosure surface: between 2.5 m and 3 m.

##### 4.4.1 IP6X Acceptance conditions

Dangerous parts protection:

- 1) The protection is satisfactory if adequate clearance is kept between the access probe and hazardous parts, and the lamp shall not light, or the test probe can not pass through the opening;
- 2) For low-voltage equipment, the access probe shall not touch hazardous live parts;
- 3) For high-voltage equipment, When the access probe is placed in the most unfavourable position(s), the equipment shall be capable of withstanding the dielectric tests as specified in the relevant product standard applicable to the equipment.

Dust proof:

The protection is satisfactory if no deposit of dust is observable inside the enclosure at the end of the test.

##### 4.4.2 IPX5 Acceptance conditions

It is the responsibility of the relevant technical committee to specify the amount of water which may be allowed to enter the enclosure and the details of a dielectric strength test, if any.

In general, if any water has entered, it shall not:

- be sufficient to interfere with the correct operation of the equipment or impair safety;
- deposit on insulation parts where it could lead to tracking along the creepage distances;
- reach live parts or windings not designed to operate when wet;
- accumulate near the cable end or enter the cable if any.

If the enclosure is provided with drain-holes, it should be proved by inspection that any water which enters does not accumulate and that it drains away without doing any harm to the equipment.

For enclosures without drain-holes, the relevant product standard shall specify the acceptance conditions if water can accumulate to reach live parts.

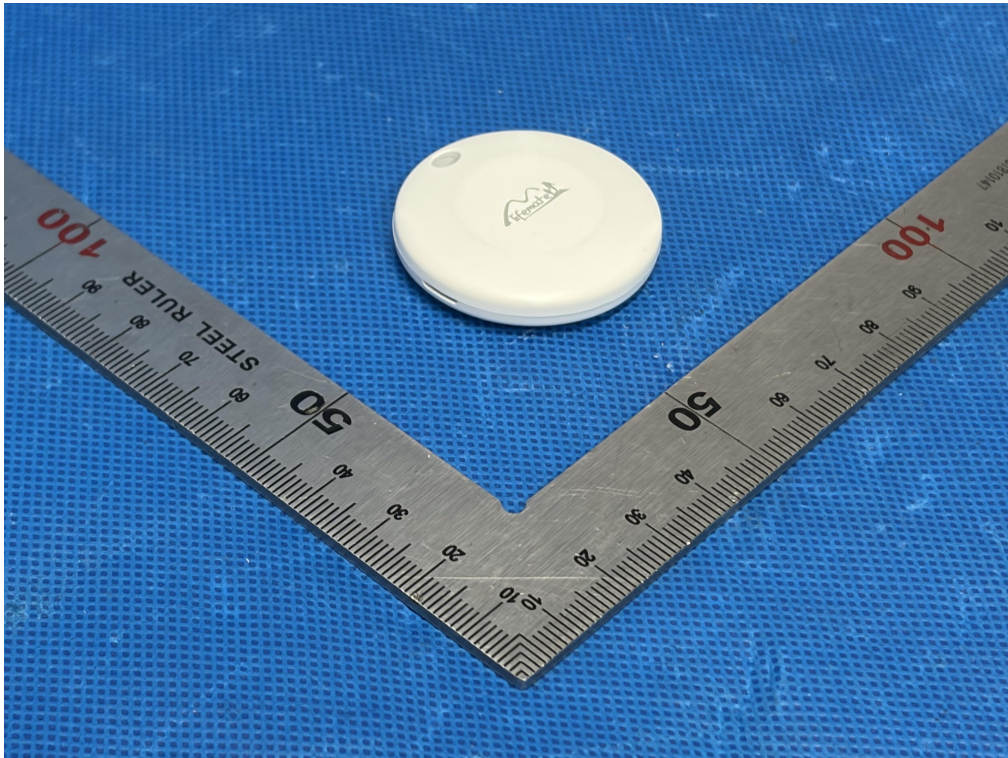

Fig.1 – Over view of product

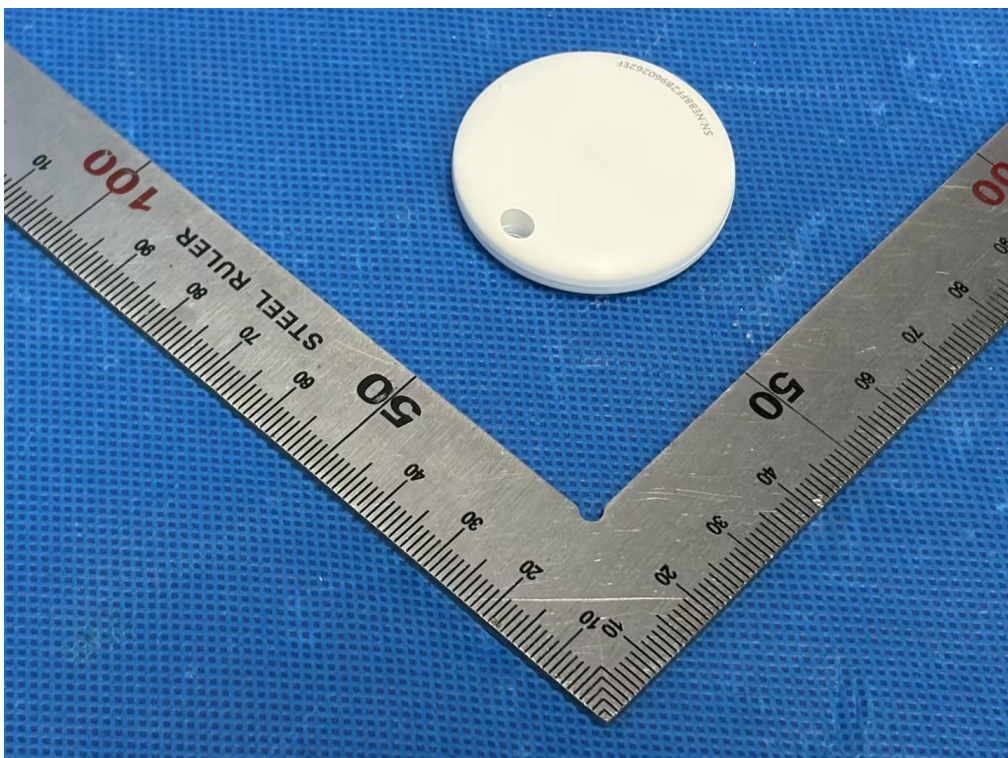


Fig.2 – Over view of product

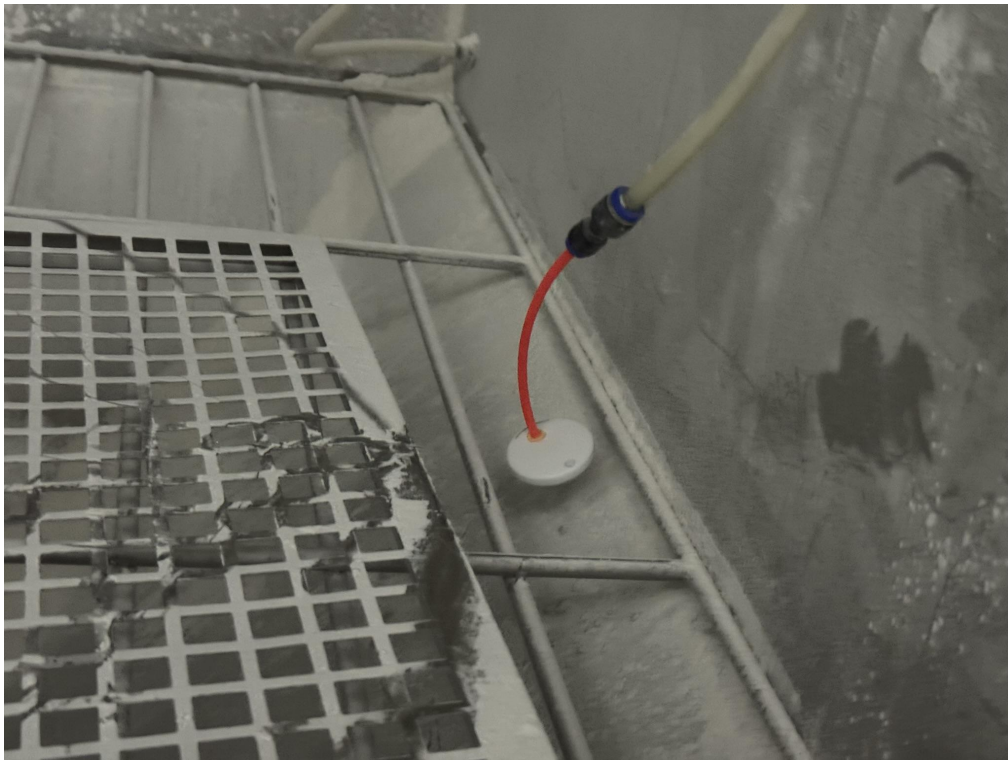


Fig.3 – View of product during test (IP6X)

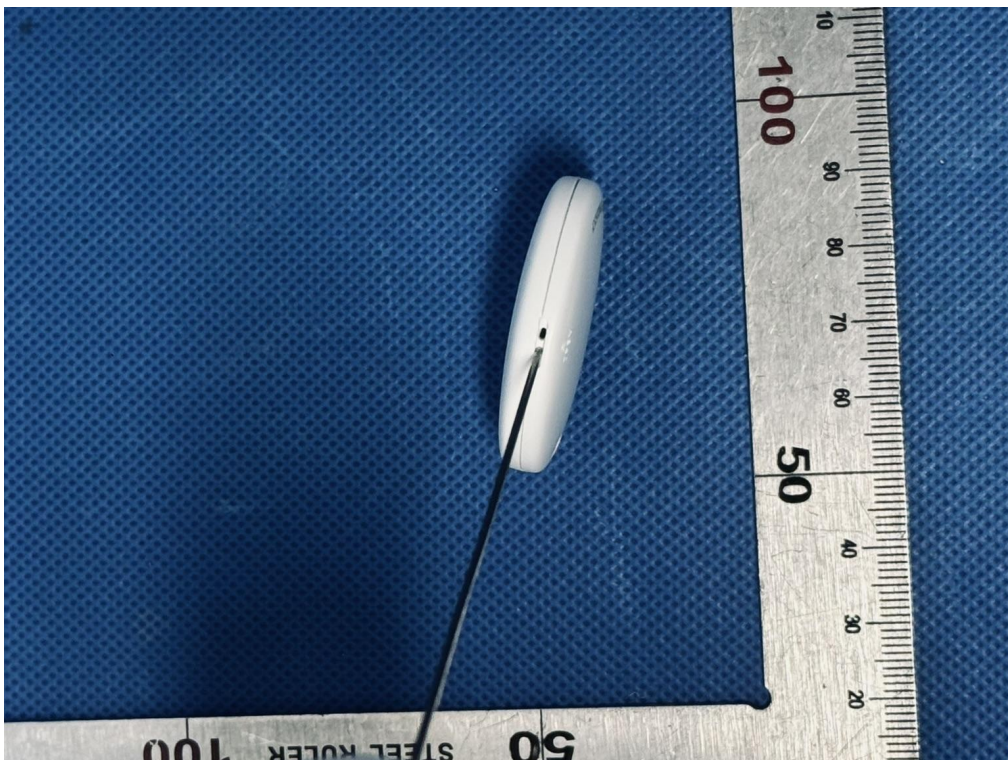


Fig.4 – View of product during test

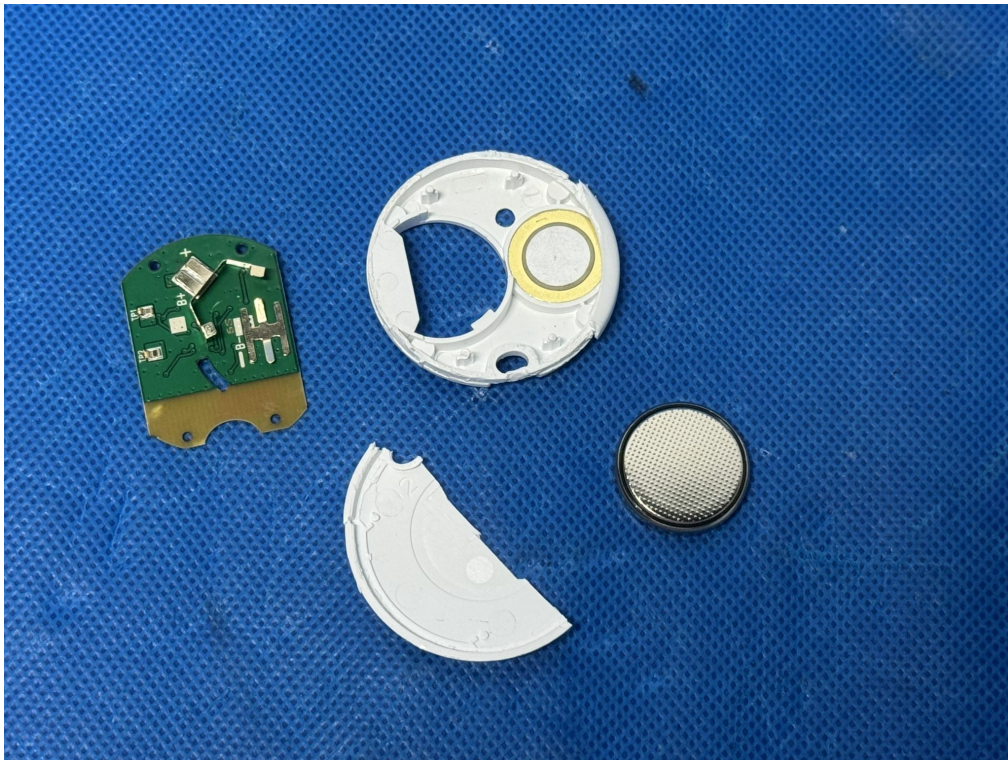


Fig.5 – View of product after test

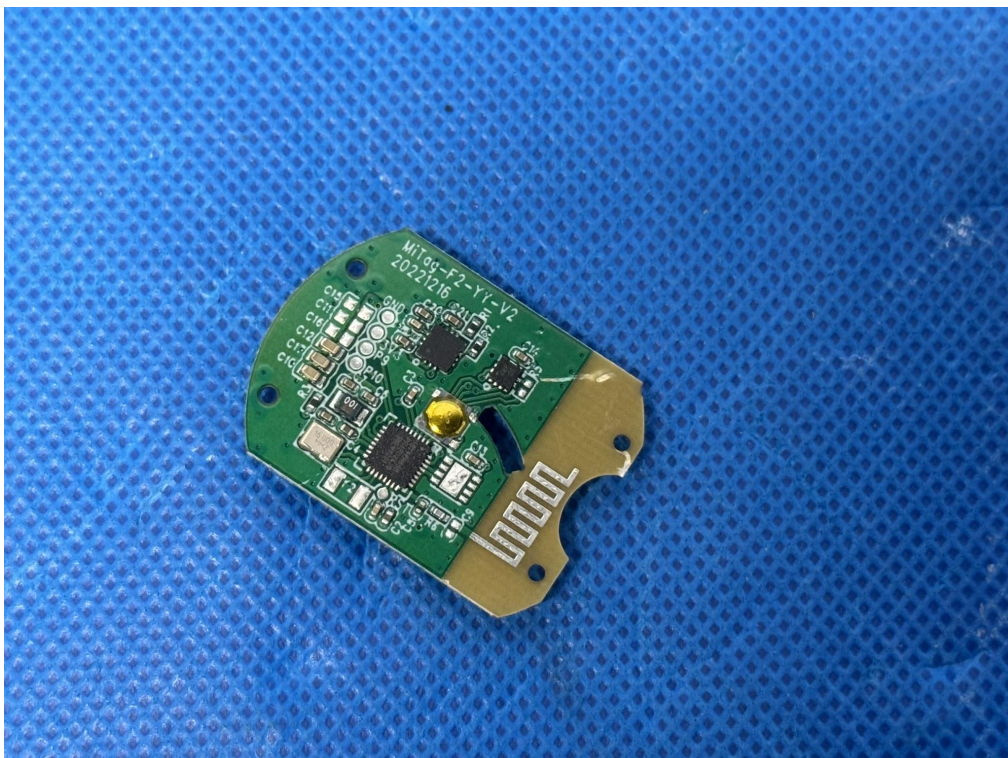


Fig.6 – View of product after test

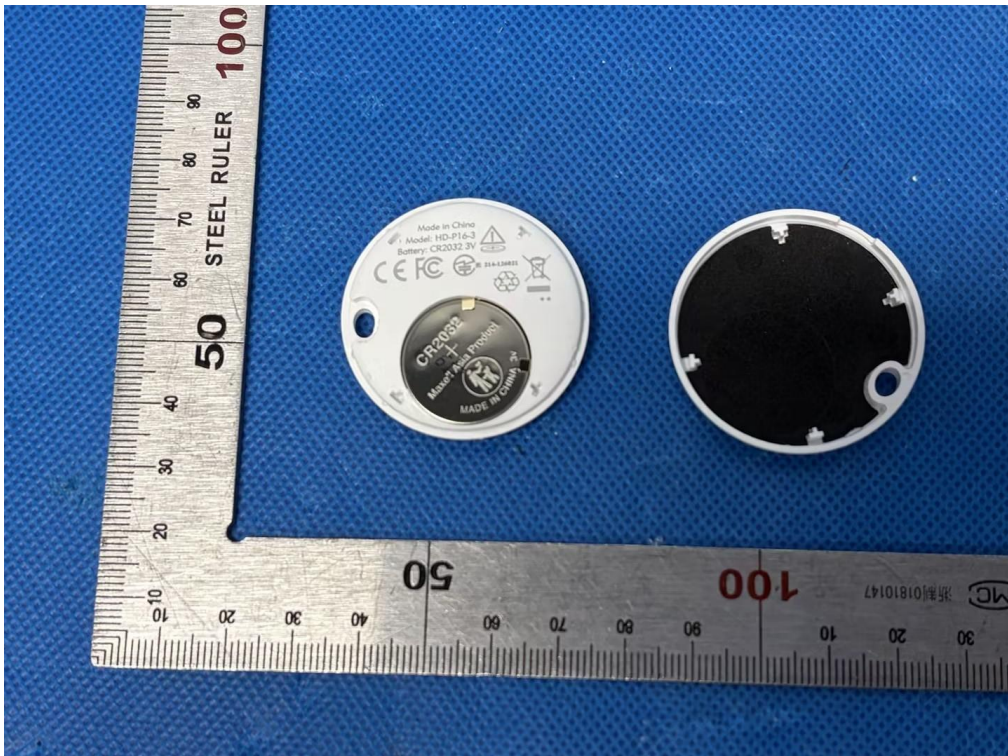


Fig.8 – View of product after test

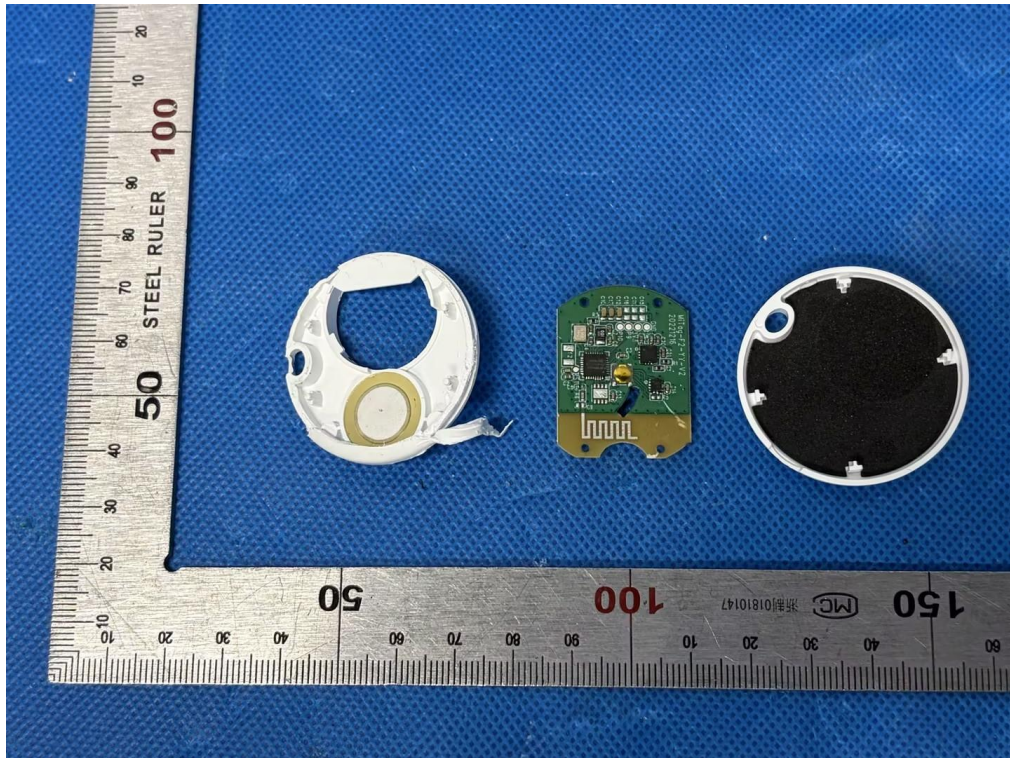


Fig.9 – View of product after test

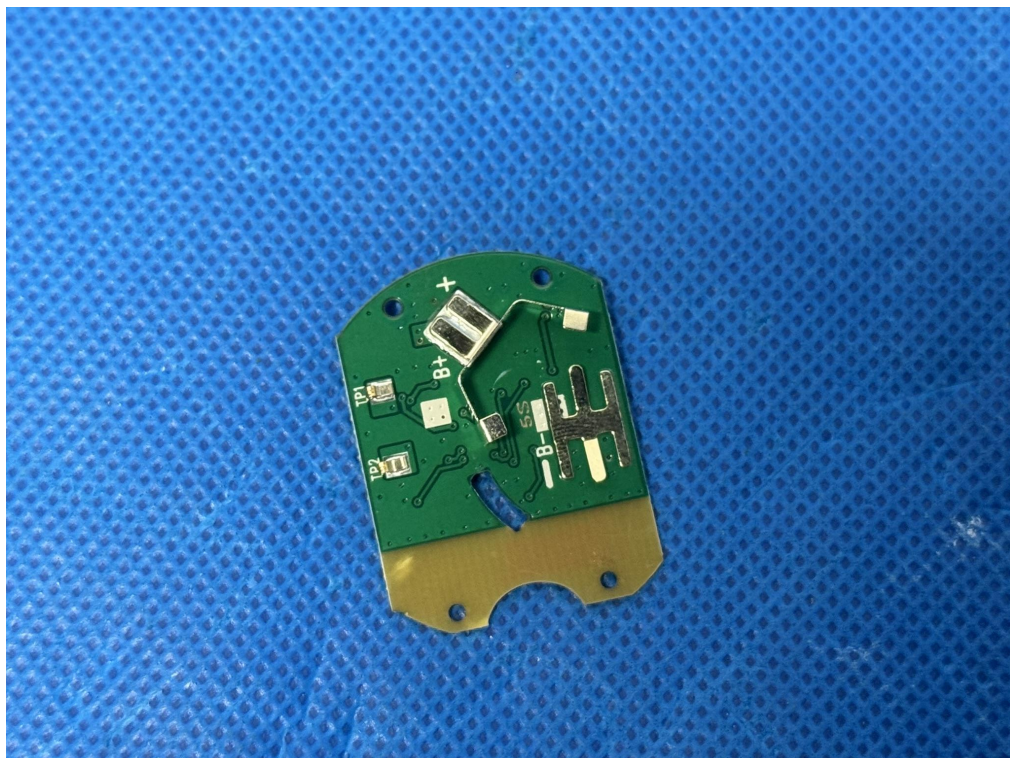


Fig.10 – View of product after test
